CAMPSITE REGULATIONS

By purchasing a ticket for the official campsite of UCI BMX World Championships and / or Ultimate Urban Festival, you agree to our campsite regulations. Campsite visitors must at all times follow the instructions of the campsite hosts, organization, security and emergency services. Please note: different house rules apply to the event area of the UCI BMX World Championships & Ultimate Urban Festival.

Sizes pitch

- The size per camping pitch is a maximum of 60m² (9x7m or 10x6m). If a larger pitch is desired, more pitches can be reserved.
- There is a maximum of 6 people per camping pitch, who can stay overnight.

Arrival and departure

- Arrival at the camping from Friday 13 August at 3:00 pm.
- Leave the campsite no later than Monday 23 August before 10:00 am.

Access Policy

- Anyone who wants to spend the night at the campsite must buy a camping ticket. After purchase you will not immediately receive an e-ticket, but a confirmation of purchase by email. Two days in advance you will receive an email with triage questions about COVID-19 and when these have been answered correctly, you will receive the e-ticket.
- The tourist tax must also be paid when purchasing a camping ticket for the number of people per camping pitch. Based upon the amount of people per campsite, you will receive the correct amount of wristbands to access the campsite upon arrival.
- Access to the campsite is only granted when showing a valid camping ticket and a valid ID (driver's license, passport or identity card). The admission ticket is personal.
- The camping ticket does not give you access to the event, for this you need to purchase a separate ticket for the event.
- Upon arrival, the vehicle must fit within the specified and reserved space. If the vehicle is too large, the guest is obliged to purchase an extra pitch.
- Upon arrival, each vehicle receives a car window sticker, with this sticker it is possible to enter and leave the campsite during the week (between 08:00 - 22:00).
- Only persons with a ticket or the correct wristband are allowed on the campsite. During the stay at the campsite it is mandatory to wear the wristband clearly visible.
- No refund will be given in case of early departure from the campsite.
- In case of calamities (urgent cases) you can contact the organization.

Camping pitch

- Follow the instructions of the organization in regards to placing the vehicle on the pitch. Be aware of keeping emergency exits, paths and passageways free for emergency services.
- A camping pitch is assigned. It is not allowed to exchange or change a camping pitch on your own initiative.
- It is not possible to reserve two places next to each other in advance. If you want to have a pitch next to each other, make sure you arrive together. For example, by meeting up at Carpoolplaats Planken Wambuis.
- It is quiet on the campsite from 23:00 - 07:00. It is forbidden to produce noise during this time that may cause disturbance to other camping guests.
- Use of open fire on the campsite is not allowed.
- BBQ at the campsite is allowed, provided that electrical or gas-operated appliances are used.
- It is mandatory, by order of the fire brigade, to be equipped with an approved fire extinguisher per vehicle.
- It is not allowed to damage the site, for example by drilling or digging holes in the ground. If damage has been done to the site, the repair costs will be charged.

Power

- Each camping pitch is supplied with 1 power point of 230v.

Waste

- We love a clean and healthy living environment! Throw waste in the bin and keep the area around your sleeping accommodation clean.
- Adequate measures are made in order for you to deposit rubbish. Garbage bags will also be distributed.
- Keep the campsite clean and put closed waste bags in the containers.
- Waste that is lying around is not being tolerated, the campsite must be free of waste at all times.

Pets

- Pets are allowed on the campsite, provided they are not a burden to other camping guests.
- Pets are prohibited on the event site.
- The campsite should not be used for walking your pets, there are plenty of opportunities in the area for walking your pets.
- When a pet has relieved itself, it should be picked up at all times, both at the designated areas which are provided and of course on the campsite itself.

Camping shop

- There will be a camping shop and / or collection point for groceries.

Other

- Staying at the campsite is entirely at your own risk.
- The organization is not liable for damage and injuries to persons as a result of staying on the site, as well as when using on-site facilities.
- The organization is not liable for loss / damage to / theft of personal belongings on the site.
- The organization is not liable for the disuse of existing facilities.
- The organization is not liable for damage claims based on noise or odor nuisance, as well as the condition of the site as a result of weather influences.
- Consuming, using, trading or carrying any narcotics is strictly prohibited (this includes nitrous oxide).
- In the event of a reasonable suspicion of the presence of prohibited items (as described in house rules), the organization can request permission to check the tent / caravan (or have it checked). In the event of refusal, the organization reserves the right to deny access to the camping and festival site and to remove you from the site without refund.
- Children must stay under the supervision of an adult. The adults are responsible for the minor's behavior. Parents and / or guardians of a minor are held liable if a violation of the regulations is committed by the minor.
- If violent crimes, vandalism, intimidation, theft and / or immoral behavior are detected, you will be removed from the site without mercy and handed over to the police.
- You are not allowed to bring food and / or drinks from the campsite to the event site.
- If you as a visitor violate the above rules, you lose the right to stay at the campsite without refund.
- It is prohibited to distribute flyers, leaflets or hang posters on or in the vicinity of the site without written permission from the organization.
- It is prohibited to take photos or films on the site of the campsite that are used for commercial or public purposes, unless with the prior written permission of the organizer.
- The organization and security expressly reserve the right to refuse entry on the grounds of inappropriate clothing. Visitors with football shirts, non-BMX related club clothing and / or clothing with nationalistic signs or expressions can be refused.

It is FORBIDDEN to bring items in the list below to the campsite.

- The following items are prohibited on the campsite of UCI BMX World Championships:
 - Drugs or other stimulants;
 - Nitrous oxide;
 - Deodorant or perfume packaging larger than 100ml;
 - Radios, speakers and other sound systems;
 - Projectiles or explosives in solid, liquid or gaseous form;
 - Flammable products or materials & aerosols;
 - Any weapon or other dangerous, sharp object;
 - Banners or objects with discriminatory and / or provocative texts and / or expressions that can be used as a means of disrupting public peace, endangering the safety of the crowd and / or causing damage to persons and property;
 - Professional film, photo or sound equipment;
 - Drones (both on the ground and in the air).

COVID-19

In the current situation, COVID-19 poses a great risk to events. In the event that COVID-19 still poses a risk to the event, the following rules apply:

- Follow the measures and instructions of the personnel.
- It is mandatory to follow all COVID-19 related measures that are applicable at that time;
- To gain access to the campsite of UCI BMX World Championships and / or the Ultimate Urban Festival, a valid health check and the provision of correct contact information is required;
- When entering the campsite of the UCI BMX World Championships and / or the Ultimate Urban Festival you agree to the storage of personal data up to 14 days after the event, for the purpose of a possible source and contact investigation;
- In case of complaints, access to the event site is excluded. Visitors who show complaints must leave the site.

If these house rules are not obtained, (further) access to the campsite of the UCI BMX World Championships and / or Ultimate Urban Festival will be irrevocably denied and the visitor will be denied a local ban. Visitors and persons who have been denied access to the campsite of UCI BMX World Championships and / or Ultimate Urban Festival by law and house rules - for whatever reason - are not entitled to any reimbursement of admission tickets, travel costs and / or all other costs incurred.

NB: these regulations are subject to change. In all cases not covered by these regulations, the organization decides; safety always comes first!
